Reflection is a crucial cognitive practice in the research field (Dahlberg, Drew, & Nyström, 2002; Steier, 1995). Starting from the “interpretive turn,” reflexivity is largely practiced in qualitative research, where it is used to legitimate and validate research procedures.

The problem of bias in qualitative research particularly is still debated in methodology texts and there is a lack of agreement on how much researcher influence is acceptable, whether or not it needs to be “controlled,” and how it might be accounted for. Denzin (1994) refers to this as “the interpretive crisis” (p. 501).

How to ... be reflexive when conducting qualitative research ...

Qualitative research is a market research method that focuses on obtaining data through open-ended and conversational communication. This method focuses on the “why” rather than the “what” people think about you. Let’s say you have an online shop that addresses a general audience.

As it is more vulnerable to subjectivity, qualitative research serves as a springboard for reflection. Authorizations and / or consents to observe human behavior, whether in isolation, in complex contexts of socialization or in others of a different nature, access to personal, private, sensitive, reserved documentation, as well as the places where one intends to access those observations and contexts, imply that they are explicit and unassailable from the legal, moral and ethical point of view.
