The campaign was the brainchild of General Wavell and in early 1941 the Allies launched a sophisticated three-pronged attack. An entirely African-raised force commanded by Major General Cunningham easily retook British Somaliland from the Italians, and pushed up through Italian Somaliland and into Ethiopia from the South. This was a breathtaking, mechanised advance across hundreds of kilometres, that saw 50 000 Italians captured for the loss of only 500 allied troops.
