Process indicators These measure the progress of activities in a program or project. Output indicators Output indicators measure the quantity, quality and timeliness of the products (goods or services) that are the result of an activity, project or program. Outcome indicators They measure the intermediate results generated by programme outputs.

Indicators for monitoring maternal and neonatal quality ...

Relevant and realistic – the monitoring and evaluation system and related indicators establish levels of performance that are likely to be achieved in a practical manner and that reflect the expectations of stakeholders. Timely – indicators need to be time sensitive to change. For example, some variables are slow changing and highly variable across years (e.g. climate), meaning that progress towards outcomes can be difficult to assess over the short term.

Monitoring health care quality is impossible without the use of clinical indicators. They create the basis for quality improvement and prioritization in the health care system. To ensure that reliable and valid clinical indicators are used, they must be designed, defined, and implemented with scientific rigour.

Prevention Quality Indicators (PQIs) are population-based indicators that capture all cases of potentially preventable complications that occur in a given population either during a hospitalization or in a subsequent hospitalization. PQIs can be used to identify admissions that might have been avoided through access to high-quality outpatient care.
