To Britain, security rested on a balance of power—a divided Europe with British power backing the weaker coalition. To Germany, bordered east and west by nations fearful of her power, security lay in unifying Europe under her leadership, as Bismarck had done. British and German concepts of security were irreconcilable.

## **The End of 'Splendid Isolation' - Churchill, Hitler and ...**

Usually British foreign policy in the twentieth century is seen as a progress from 'Isolation' to 'Commitment', a view questioned in this essay. The view that Britain was isolated stems from contemporary polemic, since Lord Salisbury's policy had been more flexible and subtle than such a simplistic description implies.

However, the term was reputedly coined in January 1896 by a Canadian politician, George Eulas Foster, who indicated his approval for Britain's minimal involvement in European affairs by saying, "In these somewhat troublesome days when the great Mother Empire stands splendidly isolated in Europe."

As Europe divided into two power blocs during the 1890s, the 1895-1905 Conservative government realised this left Britain dangerously exposed.
